

Covid Booster Information

Who can get a COVID-19 booster jab?

Booster vaccines are available on the NHS for people most at risk from COVID-19 who have already had 2 doses of a vaccine.

Frontline health or social care workers can also book their COVID-19 booster vaccinations.

The full list of those eligible includes:

- people aged 50 and over
- people who live and work in care homes
- frontline health and social care workers
- people aged 16 and over with a health condition that puts them at high risk of getting seriously ill from COVID-19
- carers aged 16 and over
- people aged 16 and over who live with someone who is more likely to get infections (such as someone who has HIV, has had a transplant or is having certain treatments for cancer, lupus or rheumatoid arthritis)
- People who are pregnant and in one of the eligible groups can also get a booster dose.

Book a booster vaccine appointment

If it's been 152 days (5 months) since your second vaccination and you are eligible you can book an appointment online.

Please note your booster dose might be different to your first or second vaccine.

Walk-in clinics

If it's been 6 months since your second vaccination and you are eligible you can get a booster jab at one of our local vaccine clinics without an appointment:

Anyone aged 16 and over can visit one of our local vaccine clinics without an appointment:

If it's been at least 8 weeks since your first vaccination you can also get your second vaccination at one of these clinics.
